HealthSpace develops and provides sophisticated information management system for the surveillance, business management, compliance and tracking of regulatory and quality control applications. Clients include government regulatory agencies and private sector businesses who require collected data along with auditing applications for the purpose of improving productivity, quality control and performance analysis.

HealthSpace’s ongoing engagement with government customers in both the US and Canada continues to drive growth and viable learning opportunities to continue to innovate our technology offerings. In 2019, we are continuing to actively introduce our platform and services into commercial enterprise clients in food & beverage, hospitality, assisted living, and child-care. Ongoing discovery work based on HealthSpace’s agricultural capabilities is now being integrated into cannabis production and distribution processes through work with both US and Canadian partners.

HealthSpace has developed several relationships within the cannabis space and has begun detailing some product changes in order to cultivate market traction. The Company is exploring opportunities with multiple regulatory agencies that oversee and regulate cannabis producers. The Company intends on leveraging its vast experience in developing SaaS platforms for enforcement and compliance into the cannabis space where there is little in the way of software offerings that adequately handle compliance.

- The Company's CEO, Silas Garrison, participated at Idea Week (<https://ideaweek.com/>), between April 8-13, on a panel discussing Blockchain in Healthcare. The panel was comprised of several notable individuals across both the public and private sectors, and discussed various ways blockchain technology can be applied to real-world scenarios.

- **On April 3, 2019, the Company announced that it had finalized its contract with the Florida State Department of Health (the "State" or "Florida"). Total value of the contract was USD \$3,213,720 for a term of five years with three additional option years, not included in the total contract value. This contract represents the largest contract the Company has signed to-date. The deployment for Florida will be used daily by over 1,100 agency employees for numerous areas within the department from licensing and inspections to billing and payments.**

The State will also be implementing numerous portions of the My Health Department platform which will allow for private companies to submit applications, pay for licensing fees, and interact with a host of other information all online. This creates an additional outlet for HealthSpace to continue its expansion of its new platform targeted at private businesses while providing the State itself a world class Cloud solution. Combining both platforms under one roof will streamline the communication and paperwork for tens of thousands of inspections performed every year and thousands of licensing applications processed on a monthly basis. This represents an additional line of revenue outside the total contract value. With the State processing tens

of millions of dollars each year, the opportunity becomes significant for HealthSpace.

- On April 8, 2019, the Company announced that it had secured four new contracts with health departments in Cudahy and South Milwaukee in Wisconsin, Dekalb County in Illinois, Walla Walla in Washington and St. Clair County in Michigan. Each of these contracts is for a three year agreement. Further, these contracts create strong representation in key areas of the US as HealthSpace continues its expansion and product adoption across multiple regions. The total value of these contracts is \$80,840 USD.
